REGIONAL DISTRICT “E” - Cultus Lake Community Centre, 4200 Columbia Valley Hwy, Cultus Lake

REGIONAL DISTRICT “E” - Chilliwack Fish & Game Protective Assoc., 48685 Chilliwack Lake Road

Elector Registration (for voting day only registration)

There is no need to pre-register to vote, as the registration of all electors for this election will take place at the time of voting. You will be required to make a declaration that you meet the following requirements:

- 18 years of age or older, or will be on general voting day;
- a Canadian citizen;
- resident of B.C. for at least 6 months immediately preceding voting day;
- resident of OR registered owner of real property in the Fraser Valley Regional District Electoral Areas “D” and “E” for at least 30 days immediately preceding voting day; and,
- not otherwise disqualified by law from voting.

Resident electors will also be required to produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

Non-resident property electors must complete an “Application for Registration as a Non-Resident Property Elector – Form No. 2-7” AND produce 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) that provide evidence of identity.

Non-resident property elector “Application for Registration as a Non-Resident Property Elector – Form No. 2-7” can be obtained from the Chief Election Officer at the Fraser Valley Regional District Office during regular office hours prior to 4:30 p.m. on Friday, November 14, 2008 or on the website at www.fvrd.bc.ca. Applications can also be obtained at the time of voter registration at each voting place.
