TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the City of Chilliwack will hold a Public Hearing, as noted above, on the following item:

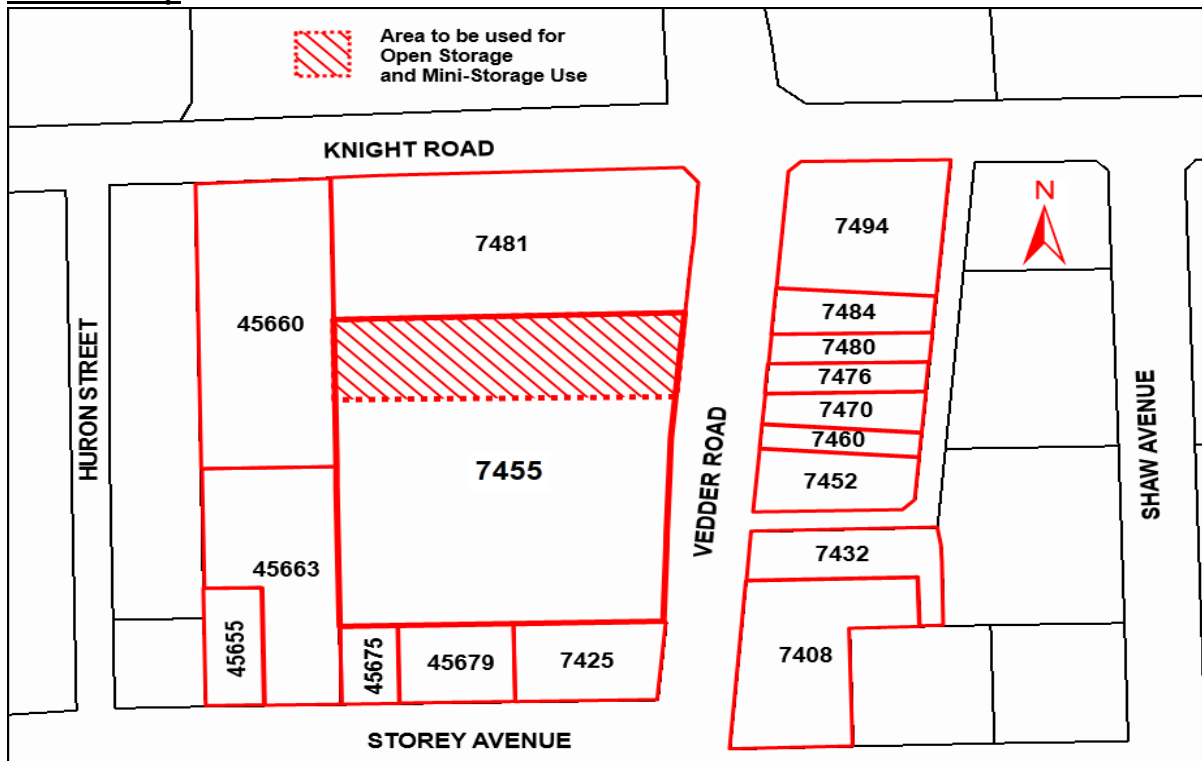
**1. TEMPORARY USE PERMIT (TUP00052)**

**Location:** 7455 Vedder Road (a portion of)

**Applicant:** Bill Driesen

**Purpose:** The applicant is seeking approval to utilize the interior of the existing commercial building as Mini-Storage Warehousing, and the area within the existing fenced compound for the Open Storage of Recreational Vehicles and Motor Vehicles, on a portion of the subject property, as shown on the map below. The property is zoned CD-25 (Comprehensive Development - 25) which does not permit the proposed use on the portion of this property; as such, a Temporary Use Permit (TUP) is required.

This notice is sent to property owners and occupants, where appropriate, of lots within 30 metres of the property subject to the permit. Persons who deem that their interest in the property is affected by the proposed Temporary Use Permit will have an opportunity to be heard at the Public Hearing or, if you are unable to attend, you may provide a written submission, **including your full name and address**, to the City Clerk's Office no later than 4:00 p.m. on the date of the Public Hearing. All submissions will be recorded and form part of the official record of the Hearing.

This proposed Temporary Use Permit may be inspected between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays, from **Wednesday, April 23, 2014 to Tuesday, May 6, 2014** both inclusive, in the Office of the City Clerk at City Hall, 8550 Young Road, Chilliwack, BC.
